Practice Schedule

Cast Absences

If a cast member will miss rehearsal for ANY reason, a parent must let Mrs. Wright know in writing—via a note or email—24 hours in advance in order to be excused. If a child misses school due to illness on the day of a rehearsal, please let Beth know this, too.

A Special Note about March 21 and 22

If you will be available for practice on these dates, please let Melissa Allison know ASAP. If enough people are available, we may add additional rehearsals March 21 and 22.

Rehearsal Notes

All orphans will also be wearing lace-up boots for the show, and we would like them to practice in them throughout rehearsals. They do not need to be in good shape.
