Cast and Crew T-Shirts

DUE THURSDAY, MARCH 22

Attached is the *Cinderella* T-shirt order form. The shirts will be gray with the logo and show information printed on the front. Shirt orders are due BEFORE SPRING BREAK, so order yours today! The cost is \$12 for short-sleeved, \$16 for long-sleeved style.

ALL Ticket/Concessions Crew and Tech Crew members must purchase and wear shirts for the performances.

The shirts are optional for cast members, but they are an excellent way to promote excitement for the show, and make a wonderful keepsake for years to come. Parents can order for themselves, too!

Cast and Crew Meals

DUE THURSDAY, MARCH 22

During late rehearsals and show time prep, the cast and crew work hard and get very hungry! But we've got them covered with convenient meals prepared and served by our volunteers. If you would like your student to participate, we will feed the cast and crew during evening dress rehearsals and before the school-day matinee and shows. The cost for the meals is \$40.

Crew Note: Tech, Props/Stage, and Hair/Makeup student crews will most likely be present at these meal times so are encouraged to participate. Tickets, Concessions, and Set Design crews have varying schedules that typically do not coincide with these meal times, so may not wish to participate (but are welcome to if desired!).

Please be aware that these meals are designed to be quick and nutritious, but they are not *gluten free, dairy* free, or vegetarian. If your student must only eat these type of items, it is very important that you provide food for your child that can be eaten during our mealtime together. All boy cast members will be wearing black dress shoes.
