K-1 Chess Club

Again this year, there will be a chess club for K-1 students who are interested. It is not required to attend the intro to chess class (noted below) to participate in this club. Players will be encouraged to participate in some tournaments when they are ready. However, tournament participate will not be required. Because all players will be expected to participate in tournaments, all players will need a USCF number. USCF #s can be obtained at <u>https://secure2.uschess.org/webstore/member.php</u>. The cost for a one year membership is \$17 for age 12 and under or \$22 for ages 13-15)
